General Information

Dear Parishioners,

At the 5:00 p.m. Mass at Sacred Heart in Olean, on next Saturday, July 31, Fr. Scott Hastings, the Vicar for Clergy for the Archdiocese of Omaha, will install me as pastor of our three parishes. While I have been officially appointed pastor by Archbishop Lucas, I, also, have to be installed in order to be able to do such things as officiate at weddings. I pass this information on to you, if you are interested in being present. It is a fairly simple and brief ceremony that will take place after the Gospel. Most of all, please keep me in your prayers as I am installed as your pastor.

In regards to the matter of the weekend Mass schedule, I have received requests that there be a 7:00 pm Mass on Saturdays. In response to this, I am going to do a two-month trial of offering a 7:00 p.m. Mass on Saturdays, alternating between Saints Cyril and Methodius and St. Wenceslaus parishes. I will begin this on Saturday, September 11 and go through Saturday, November 6. The 7:00 pm. Mass will be in Clarkson on the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month and in Dodge on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays of the month. If I see that this Mass time is well attended and that I judge that it is manageable for me to do, I will next year provide the 7:00 pm Mass during the months of Daylight Savings Time in this alternation between Clarkson and Dodge. When there are five Saturdays in a month, if it is an odd month, this Mass would be in Clarkson, and, if an even month, it would be in Dodge on the 5th Saturday. The 5:00 p.m. Mass at Sacred Heart in Olean on Saturdays and the 8:00 a.m. Mass at St. Wenceslaus and 10:00 a.m. at Saints Cyril and Methodius on Sundays will continue throughout the whole year.

I pray that all of you have a blessed and grace-filled week.
