SPIRITUAL INSIGHT: Fr. Michel N'DO

Brothers and sisters,

This Sunday's readings shake us awake to a truth we often overlook: we are sent by God—and we are never sent alone.

In the Gospel, Jesus sends out seventy-two disciples two by two. Not solo heroes, but companions on a shared mission. He tells them, "The harvest is abundant... go!" No money bag, no sandals, no backup plan—just trust. Travel light. Carry peace. Be vulnerable, yes—but step out boldly. Why? Because the power is not in what we bring, but in who sends us.

Isaiah paints a stunning image of that Sender: not a distant commander, but a mother who cradles her child. "As a mother comforts her child, so I will comfort you." The One who sends us out is also the One who holds us close.

So, wherever this week takes you, remember this: you are a disciple on the move. A carrier of peace. A witness to joy. And if the journey feels heavy, return to the heart of it all: the Kingdom of God is already near—it is here, hidden in every act of trust, every word of mercy, every heart that risks love.
