

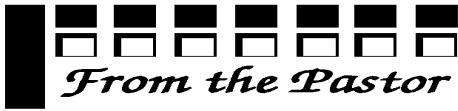

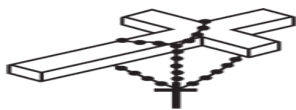

Catholic Charities provides for those who go hungry.
